Sub.: Conduct of OET Round-5 for filling residual vacancies in the Three-Year B.Sc. (Hospitality & Hotel Administration) Programme for Academic Session 2026-27 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

The National Council for Hotel Management & Catering Technology (NCHMCT) has conducted various rounds of the Online Entrance Test (OET) for filling the residual vacancies in the Three-Year B.Sc. (Hospitality & Hotel Administration) Programme for the Academic Session 2026-27. The result of OET Round-4 has been made live on the Admission Portal.

2. In order to fill the remaining vacancies, after the allotment of seats to candidates of OET Round-4, it has been decided to conduct OET Round-5. The fifth Round of OET i.e., OET Round-5 Examination is proposed to be held on **31.08.2026 (Monday) from 11:00 AM to 12:00 Noon**.

3. All affiliated Institutes are requested to facilitate the registration of eligible candidates through the same User ID provided for the Institutional Login Portal (<https://nchmct.in>). The particulars of each candidate should be entered carefully on the portal. After successful registration for OET Round-5, the same procedure for uploading of necessary documents and remittance of non-refundable and non-adjustable Registration Fee of ₹2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) is followed as done in previous round of OET.

4. It may kindly be noted that the Registration Fee paid by a candidate shall be valid **only for the OET Round for which the candidate has registered** and shall neither be refunded nor adjusted against any subsequent OET Round.

5. Institutes are advised to ensure that candidates verify the correctness of their Email ID and Mobile Number before submission of the application, as all future communications relating to the examination, seat allotment and admission shall be communicated through the registered Email ID and the Admission Portal. The detailed guidelines pertaining to the Online Entrance Test (OET), including the registration process, login credentials, examination schedule, and payment of the Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF), are enclosed herewith for your ready reference.

6. The registration facility for **OET Round-5** shall remain open up to **29.08.2026 (Saturday) till 4:00 PM**. Thereafter, the registration link for Round-5 shall be deactivated automatically. You are, therefore, requested to ensure that all eligible and interested candidates are registered well before the closing date so as to avoid last-minute difficulties or technical issues.

7. Institutes are also requested to remind candidates to check their registered Email ID (including the Spam/Junk Folder) and the NCHMCT Website (www.nchm.gov.in) for examination updates, result declaration, seat allotment and other important communications. NCHMCT shall not be responsible for any delay arising due to non-receipt of emails or failure on the part of the candidate to regularly check the NCHMCT Website/delay in communication on the part of the Institute.

8. I would request you to disseminate the information to the prospective candidates so that maximum number of candidates shall participate in this round of OET.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OET

1. Institute-assisted Registration:

Candidates who are unable to complete the online registration process independently may approach any participating Institute for assistance. The Institute may register such candidates through its authorised Institute Login, subject to verification of the requisite documents and information furnished by the candidate. The role of the Institute shall be limited solely to facilitating the registration process. The accuracy, completeness, and authenticity of all information and documents submitted shall remain the sole responsibility of the candidate. Candidates registered through an Institute Login shall be considered only for admission against the seats available in the Institute through which they have been onboarded on the Admission Portal.

2. Login Credentials:

For all candidates, whether self-registered or registered through an Institute, the default **User ID** shall be the registered Email ID or Mobile Number, and the default **Password** shall be the Roll Number allotted to the candidate. Upon first login, it is advised to change the default password immediately for security purposes and carefully retain their User ID and newly created password, as the same shall be required for all future activities relating to the admission process.

3. Communication of Examination Details:

It shall be the responsibility of the Institute to communicate the examination schedule and the online examination link to the candidates well in advance. Candidates shall appear for the Online Entrance Test (OET) only through the examination link provided.

4. Admission Portal:

The NCHM Admission Portal (<https://nchmct.in/login>) shall serve as the primary platform for all activities relating to the admission process. Through their respective login credentials, candidates may access and download the examination schedule, online examination link, examination result, Institute (IHM) allotment details, Seat Allotment Offer Letter, payment receipt of the Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF), and the Provisional Seat Allotment Letter. Candidates are advised to visit the Admission Portal regularly for updates, notifications, and further instructions relating to the admission process.

5. Pattern of Online Entrance Test (OET):

The examination shall be conducted in **online mode** and shall be of **one hour** duration, comprising **60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)** distributed as follows:

Subject	No. of MCQs
Numerical Ability and Analytical Aptitude	10
Reasoning and Logical Deduction	10
General Knowledge and Current Affairs	10
English Language	20
Aptitude for the Service Sector	10
Total	60

Each question shall have four answer options, of which only one shall be correct. Candidates shall select the correct option for each question.

- **Correct Answer:** +1 mark
- **Incorrect Answer:** –0.25 mark
- **Unattempted Question:** No marks shall be awarded or deducted.

Candidates may appear for the examination from any location using a suitable device (Desktop Computer, Laptop, Tablet, or Smartphone) with a stable internet connection.

6. **Result, Seat Acceptance Fee and Allotment Letter:**

The result, indicating the rank secured by the candidate and the Institute allotted, shall be published on the Admission Portal (<https://nchmct.in/login>). The candidate can view result, allotment and pay the SAF amount directly through the online payment mechanism available on the Admission portal. Upon successful remittance of the Seat Acceptance Fee, the candidate shall be able to download the **Seat Allotment Letter** through the Admission Portal.

The Institute may also collect the SAF amount from the candidate and remit the amount to NCHCMT through NEFT/RTGS, the Bank details for such remittance is given below:
